I. [Call to Order](#)

Mr. Wally Hansen called the TCC meeting to order at 10:32 am, Thursday, May 9, 2019, at Jacksonville Onslow Commerce Center Executive Conference Room – 1099 Gum Branch Road., Jacksonville, NC.

Mr. Hansen welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were made. Mr. Anthony Prinz introduced Mr. Trevor Carroll as the new District Engineer for NCDOT.

V. [P5.0 Update](#)

Ms. Deanna Trebil talked about the updated work program. Stating NCDOT informed TCC and TAC that they are pushing out the adoption for the proposed STIP. It will be in September verses June. Ms. Trebil informed the committee that the dates have changed slightly. We are currently working on the MTP to get it before the board for approval in the coming months.

VI. [P6.0 Work Plan](#)

Ms. Stephanie Kutz mentioned we are going right into P6.0 Work Plan after the P5.0 Update. This work plan at this time does not reflect a delay. We are looking to issue a call for projects on June 1, 2019. There is a meeting change for this plan that will take place in August instead of September. We are looking to adopt the next MTIP in October of 2021 for 2022-2031. Mr. Prinz stated this process is how we get funding to build roadway improvements and other transportation projects in our area.

Ms. Kutz stated there will be a TCC Subcommittee meeting and also a public meeting in August. This will give us public comments to take to TCC and they will discuss the projects that will be submitted, then it will go to TAC before projects are submitted. It will be due at the end of September.

VII. [Draft 2020-2029 STIP](#)

Ms. Trebil advised the committee there are summary of changes that were submitted and approved. Ms. Trebil discussed three of the changes that were highlighted.

VIII. [Jacksonville Parkway Extension](#)

Mr. Prinz provided the committee an update of where we are for the Jacksonville Parkway Extension. He explained we are required to maintain the LRTP (Long Range Transportation Plan).

Mr. Prinz asked for support from the TCC to go forward to the TAC to indoctrinate this and move us pass the next 20 years.

Mr. Hansen asked for a motion to support the concept distributing the traffic pending information and approval from TAC.

Mr. Ron Massey moved to approve the motion to support the concept distributing the traffic pending information and approval from TAC. Ms. Carol Long seconded the motion.

The motion to support the concept distributing the traffic pending approval from TAC was unanimously approved by the Committee Members present.

IX. [TRAC Update](#)

Ms. Trebil gave an update for TRAC, stating there have been several meetings and thanks to Ms. Kristina Solberg for finding more money to fund the project.

X. [MVPS Update](#)

Mr. Prinz discussed the highways for economic development and storm preparedness. Should we invest more in Highway 24 and less in other places? With investments the freeway connectivity is practical. Most of the projects between Fayetteville and Hwy 40 is funded.
